Format

- Standard Seeding for preliminary events
- Heats and Finals.
- **Heats in Standard Format**. (Swimmers compete against similar times, not same ages)
- Swimmers with no time will be seeded in slower heats.
- Finals: Top 6 athletes will swim in their specific division per event.
- No DQ's for 6 & Under events, and they get to visit the treasure chest! ©
- 6 & U events are not official events and are not scored.
- 6 & Under events will be swum as timed finals.
- Relays will be swum as timed finals after heats and before finals each day.

Events

• Each competitor may enter up to 4 individual events and 2 relays.

Announcements

- PA/Loudspeaker system will not operate until 8:00 am.
- Limited to the pool area only.
- Swimmers are responsible to be at the clerk of the course for their events.
- NO individual calls.

- Entries must be accompanied by:
 - List of your O Cat swimmer names
 - Active Team roster in excel or PDF
 - o Phone number
 - Contact name
- Swimmers may enter up to 4 events.
- Swimmers must be registered with BCSSA in 2019.
- Relay cards in by 9:30 am each morning. No exceptions.
- HY-TEK Meet Manager 6.0 will be in use for this meet.



Deck Entries: Any entry made after July 8, 7 pm.

- Accepted at the discretion of the CMR or designate
- Deck Entry Fee: \$10.00 exact cash per entry OR cheque payable to BCSSA-FV
- Deck Entry Form: Available in the Crash Desk File Folder.
- Deck Entry Process: Coaches to fully complete the Deck Entry Form including the swimmer ID number, obtain the cash or cheque and then hand into the CMR. Deck Entries not loaded in the meet until form complete and \$ in CMR's hand.
- No changing of events and no reseeding and no new heats created for deck entries.

Meet Scratches

- Scratches may be emailed up until 6 pm Friday July 12, 2019 (preferred).
- After July 13, please hand deliver to crash desk by 7:15 each day.

Entry Fees

- Fraser Valley Summer Swim Clubs: According to the regional fee agreement.
- Out of region clubs: \$25 per swimmer for 4 individual and 2 relay events.
- No refunds for late scratches.
- No entry until payment received by meet manager or designate

Marshalling

• There will be a total of 3 calls to marshalling for each event over the public address system after 8:00 am. These are courtesy calls only. Official calls for an event will take place in Marshalling by the Clerk of the Course.

Meet Rules

- 2019 BCSSA rules will apply along with the following:
 - Meet Manager reserves the right to modify the meet format
- 6 & under events start at the shallow end. Diving is not permitted.
- The Clerk of the Course may choose to combine "O" swimmers with the "S" swimmers for heats.
- The Clerk of the Course or CMR may combine events in heats and finals at his/her discretion in accordance with BCSSA rules.
- Relay teams will be swum in Division categories. Relay teams are to be entered into the event corresponding with the oldest swimmer.
- Relay Teams with mixed S and O cat Swimmers will be disqualified as per BCSSA rules.
- Relay team lists must be handed in to the Clerk of the Course by 9:30 am on the BCSSA cards.
- False Start Rule is in effect. In the event of a false start the race shall continue and the offending swimmer shall be disqualified at the end of the race.
- For any special considerations a written request to the Meet Manager submitted no later than 7:15am on Saturday July 13, 2019.
- Swimmers are to stay in the water until the next race begins, unless instructed to leave the pool earlier by the starter or referee.
